

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency provides grants to local governments to investigate solid waste management systems, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to further develop environmentally acceptable methods of solid waste disposal, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes this program is in the best public interest,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, Washington, as follows:

1. That an application be made to the Environmental Protection Agency for grant funds to study the feasibility of utilizing certain solid wastes as fuel for electricity-producing power plants.

2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute and to file such application with the Environmental Protection Agency and to execute such contracts as are required by said office.

3. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is hereby authorized to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by the Environmental Protection Agency and to act as the authorized correspondent for King County.

4. That the United States of America, and the Environmental Protection Agency are hereby assured full compliance with such regulations effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
