



MOTION NO. 176

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WHEREAS, the condition of many pieces of operating equipment in the Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Division, is uneconomical to maintain and repair and particularly unsafe for continued operation; and,

WHEREAS, establishing ownership in regularly required equipment permits reduced operating costs while developing equity interest; and,

WHEREAS, limited requirements exist now for improvement to facilities; and,

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are not available from operating revenues to implement the planned equipment replacement program and facility improvements required for the Solid Waste Division; and,

WHEREAS, significant time is required to establish equipment specifications, to advertise bids, to evaluate and establish actual acquisition costs, and to prepare, authorize and sell limited General Obligation Bonds and such information is necessary to enable the Council to make a decision as to the issuance of the bonds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

That the Council request the County Executive proceed to secure advisory bids upon equipment and facilities recommended for the Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Division.
