

MOTION NO. 520

WHEREAS, unemployment in King County exceeds 13% of the labor force according to the Washington State Employment Security Department, and

WHEREAS, King County has funds available from voter approved bond issues to implement Parks Development projects which have already received Design Commission development approval, and

WHEREAS, the management of accelerated Public Works requires added temporary staff in the Department of Parks and Recreation and the Office of Architecture to immediately implement development,

NOW, THEREFORE, does the King County Council authorize the County Executive to proceed with hiring of six contract employees by the Department of Parks and Recreation and one added person by the Office of Architecture using funds from the Forward Thrust Parks Improvement Bond Issue to provide for the necessary salaries.
