THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL DECLARING:

SW 99th Street (8th Avenue SW to 5th Avenue SW)

A NECESSITY:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable by the County Council of King County, Washington, by majority vote, that a road known as SW 99th Street

be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline;

Beginning at the intersection of 8th Avenue SW and SW 100th Street, said point being S 1° 41' 08" E, a distance of 1,276.51 feet from the north ¼ corner of Section 6, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.; thence in an easterly direction a distance of 1,010.04 feet to a terminus; said terminus being S 16° 42' 46" W, a distance of 1,164.93 feet from the NE corner of Government Lot 2, located in said Section 6.

1,010.04 Feet = 0.19 Miles

The King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway along the course and description set forth is a public necessity and directs the Director of the Department of Public Works to make an examination of said road and report upon same as required by law.
