A MOTION relating to a study of multiple use of Trail Corridor No. 6A.

WHEREAS, the report "Urban Trails Plan" as submitted by the King County Department of Planning and approved and recommended by the Environmental Development Commission has been approved by the Council, and

WHEREAS, the Council would like to study the feasibility of multiple use of Trail Corridor No. 6A, Seattle Section North (Burlington Northern Railroad Route) to possibly provide that a portion of the tracks be retained for a Northwestern Historical Railroad Museum,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

That the County Executive be directed to study the feasibility of an expanded multiple use of a portion of Trail Corridor No. 6A and report back to the Council within thirty (30) days.
