

MOTION NO. 637

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to submit a grant application to the Washington State Traffic Safety Commission for a King County Road Maintenance, Highway Design, Construction and Maintenance Inventory Program.

WHEREAS, the U. S. Department of Transportation, through the Washington State Traffic Safety Commission, is authorized to make grants under the Highway Safety Act of 1966, 23 U.S.C. 402, and

WHEREAS, this project is designed to provide a complete and current inventory of road conditions, roadside hazards as well as to develop and implement a system to determine the type and cost of improvements necessary for road maintenance, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has determined that this project is a necessary step in the development and implementation of a comprehensive road maintenance program,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County, as follows:

1. The County Executive is authorized to submit an application to the Washington State Traffic Safety Commission for a grant of matching funds to carry out a road maintenance inventory in King County.

2. The County Executive is further authorized to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the Washington State Traffic Safety Commission.

3. The Federal/State Grant Coordinator is designated as the authorized correspondent to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by the Washington State Traffic Safety Commission.

4. The United States of America, the Department of Transportation and the State of Washington are hereby assured of full compliance by King County with the regulations effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
