A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to submit an application to the Washington Planning and Community Affairs Agency, Law and Justice Planning Office for a grant award to continue the Corrections Development Project, King County Public Safety Department.

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the U. S. Department of Justice through the Washington State Planning and Community Affairs Agency, Law and Justice Planning Office, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to further develop an improved coordinated corrections program through additional funding assistance, and

WHEREAS, this application permits the implementation of phase three of an on-going five phase project, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes this program is in the best public interest,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application to the Law and Justice Planning Office for additional grant funds to continue the Corrections Development Project.

2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the Law and Justice Planning Office.

3. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is named the authorized correspondent for King County and further authorized to furnish such information and documents as may be required by the Law and Justice Planning Office.

4. That the United States of America, Department of Justice, and the State of Washington, are hereby assured full compliance with such regulations effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
