A Motion setting the date of hearing
on a Final Assessment Roll for King
County Road Improvement District No. 51.

WHEREAS, on September 28, 1970, the County Council of
King County, Washington, passed Ordinance No. 577 establishing
King County Road Improvement District No. 51, and

WHEREAS, the construction of the improvement has now
been completed, and the exact cost of the improvement is now
known, and

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 577 directed the
Director of the Department of Public Works, upon determination of
the cost of the improvement, to prepare and file with the
Administrator-Clerk of the King County Council an Assessment Roll
for that portion of the entire cost and expense of said improve-
ment to be assessed against the property included within Road
Improvement District No. 51, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works
has now prepared and filed said Final Assessment Roll with the
Administrator-Clerk of the King County Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King
County:

Section 1: Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W.
36.88.090, the hearing upon the Final Assessment Roll for King
County Road Improvement District No. 51 shall be scheduled for
DECEMBER 20, 1971, at 9:30 a.m.

Section 2: The King County Council will sit as a board
of equalization for the purpose of considering aforesaid assess-
ment roll at aforesaid hearing or hearings and will consider such
objections as are made thereto or any part thereof, and will
correct, revise, raise, lower, change or modify said rolls or any
part thereof, or set aside said roll in order that such assessment

3 be made de nova as to such body shall appear just and equitable
4 and then proceed to confirm the same by ordinance.

5 Section 3: The Administrator-Clerk of the King County
6 Council is hereby directed to give notice of hearing upon said
7 roll to all owners or reputed owners of the property whose name
8 appears thereon by mailing a notice thereof at least fifteen (15)
9 days before the date fixed for the hearing to such owners or
10 reputed owners at the address of such as shown on the tax rolls
11 of the County Treasurer; in addition thereto, such notices shall
12 be published at least two (2) times in a newspaper of general
13 circulation in the County. Such notices shall specify the time
14 and place of hearing on said roll and shall notify all persons
15 who may desire to object thereto to make such objections in
16 writing and to file same with the Administrator-Clerk of the
17 Council at or prior to the date fixed for said hearing.
