

1 WHEREAS, King County, State of Washington, acquired certain lands for
2 diking and river protection along the Snoqualmie River, under Deed dated April
3 21, 1964, and recorded under Auditor's File No. 5735308, and

4 WHEREAS, portions of subject lands lie within the right of way of State
5 Highway SR90, Echo Lake Interchange to Tanner, and

6 WHEREAS, it has become necessary to convey and/or grant to the State of
7 Washington, lands which lie within the proposed right of way, together with
8 the necessary construction easements, and

9 WHEREAS, it has been determined that Seven Hundred (\$700.00) Dollars and
10 the Mutual Benefits derived, is a fair and equitable consideration for the con-
11 veyance to the State of Washington for right of way, together with access
12 rights, construction easement and severance, and all other damages of whatso-
13 ever kind or nature to the remaining lands by reason of the location, con-
14 struction, operation and maintenance of said highway, and

15 WHEREAS, the King County Council has determined that said lands are sur-
16 plus, and that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County and
17 the State of Washington, to convey to the State of Washington, those portions
18 of the aforesaid lands which fall within the proposed right of way of SR90,
19 Echo Lake Interchange to Tanner, all being described in the attached "Exhibit
20 A".

21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 That said lands are surplus and that it is necessary to convey to the
23 State of Washington the required right of way above mentioned, and authorizes
24 the County Executive to execute the instruments in favor of the State of Wash-
25 ington, necessary for the State of Washington to acquire said rights of way to
26 SR90, Echo Lake Interchange to Tanner.
