

## MOTION

NO. 656

A MOTION authorizing the submission of a grant application by King County with the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington, on behalf of the King County Council on Alcoholism.

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U. S. Dept. of Justice, through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the problem of alcoholism as a detriment to community peace and development, and

WHEREAS, this grant application would permit the convening of a two-day workshop-seminar for personnel from concerned judicial and rehabilitative agencies dealing with the problem of alcoholism through the criminal justice system,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application to the Law and Justice Planning Office on behalf of the King County Council on Alcoholism for a grant to convene said workshop.

2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the Law and Justice Planning Office.

3. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the Law and Justice Planning Office.

4. That the United States of America, Department of Justice, and the State of Washington, are hereby assured full compliance with such regulations effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
