WHEREAS, private investors have requested the County to suspend further activity toward the construction of a public stadium to enable them to proceed with plans for the construction of a domed multipurpose stadium; and

WHEREAS, if the requested delay is granted and the private interests are unable to proceed with the plans, considerable delay and increased costs may result; and

WHEREAS, it is beneficial to the public to encourage private interests to develop industry and convention related activities in King County; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to determine the attitude of the public with regard to incurring the risk of delay and increased costs;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby moved that we hold a public hearing on the 29th day of November 1971 at 1:30PM to:

- (1) Present to the public the proposed stadium plans for a public stadium including funding, estimated costs, and time schedule;
- (2) Present to the public the proposed stadium plans of the private investors including funding, estimated costs, and time schedule;
