2 A MOTION relating to the King County Stadium
3 holding a public hearing thereon.

4 WHEREAS, private investors have requested the County
5 to suspend further activity toward the construction of a public
6 stadium to enable them to proceed with plans for the construction
7 of a domed multipurpose stadium; and

8 WHEREAS, if the requested delay is granted and the
9 private interests are unable to proceed with the plans, considerable
10 delay and increased costs may result; and

11 WHEREAS, it is beneficial to the public to encourage
12 private interests to develop industry and convention related
13 activities in King County; and

14 WHEREAS, the Council desires to determine the attitude
15 of the public with regard to incurring the risk of delay and
16 increased costs;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby moved that we hold a
18 public hearing on the 29th day of November 1971 at 1:30PM to:

- 19 (1) Present to the public the proposed stadium plans
20 for a public stadium including funding, estimated
21 costs, and time schedule;
- 22 (2) Present to the public the proposed stadium plans
23 of the private investors including funding,
24 estimated costs, and time schedule;
