A MOTION stating the intention of King County to comply with the Shoreline Management Act of 1971, requiring the completion of a shoreline inventory and development of a master program.

WHEREAS, King County, Washington concurs with the intent of the Shoreline Management Act of 1971; and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes the need for a comprehensive program relating to the utilization, protection, restoration, and preservation of shorelines within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes the necessity of a thorough inventory of shorelines and shoreline resources within the County on which to base such a program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of King County, Washington:

That it is the policy of King County to complete an inventory and develop a master program for the shorelines of the state within the jurisdiction of King County as provided for in Section 8 of the Shoreline Management Act of 1971.
