A Motion regarding a Regional Airport Authority and establishing a special Council Committee.

WHEREAS, King County, together with other governmental authorities, has conducted several studies over a period of many years, most recently the Dixon Speas Report, regarding a Regional Airport Authority, and

WHEREAS, such studies have indicated the necessity for an airport authority to administer the publicly-owned airports in King, Kitsap, Pierce and Snohomish counties, and

WHEREAS, regional airport authorities operating in other areas of the United States have proven to increase airport efficiency, improve airport operations and insure greater safety to the public,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County that:

1. A special Council Airport Committee be established, consisting of the Chairman of the Council, the Chairman of the Finance Committee and the Chairman of the Public Works and Transportation Committee, for the purpose of reviewing existing studies of regional airport authority and recommending positive action to be taken among the four counties to implement such an authority;

2. No action shall be taken to transfer authority, title or responsibility of Boeing International Airport (County Airport) to another governmental agency until a four-county intergovernmental agreement has been reached and a regional airport authority has been established.
