A MOTION authorizing the submission of a grant application by King County to the Law and Justice Planning Office, Planning and Community Affairs Agency, State of Washington.

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice, through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office, and;

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need for corrections and judicial personnel to develop new methods to break the recidivism cycle of a substantial percentage of offenders, and;

WHEREAS, this grant would provide a means for assisting corrections and judicial personnel in making decisions regarding alternatives to incarceration for female offenders;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application to the Law and Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the Law and Justice Planning Office;

3. That the Law and Justice Grant Coordinator is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the Law and Justice Planning Office;

4. That the United States of America, Department of Justice, and the State of Washington, are hereby assured full compliance with such regulations effecting Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
