MOTION NO. 714

A MOTION indicating the Council's approval and endorsing the concept for the development of Marymoor Park, Stage I, and for the Master Plan for Luther Burbank Park, and urging the expeditious development of these park sites.

WHEREAS, the County Council in its Legislative Intent for 1972 expressed a desire to be regularly briefed on all Capital Improvement Projects, and

WHEREAS, on January 12, 1972, a presentation was made to the Environmental Planning Committee on the development of Marymoor Park, Stage I, and the Master Plan for Luther Burbank Park, and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Planning Committee unanimously approved of the plans for the development of these park sites and urged that they be expedited,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the County Council of King County

(1) The Council hereby concurs in and adopts the recommendation of the Environmental Planning Committee and approves the concept for the development of Marymoor Park, Stage I, and the Master Plan for Luther Burbank Park, and

(2) The Council hereby urges the expeditious development of these park projects.
