A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office in the amount of \$37,408 for assistance in establishing a Correctional Counseling Program in the Public Defender's Office.

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice, through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning Office, and;

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to offer defendants, the courts and society the opportunity to genuinely rehabilitate offenders through the use of appropriate community resources, and;

WHEREAS, this grant would provide a means to match the needs of a defendant with available community resources to best serve the mutual goals of our judicial system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED, by the Council of King County:

1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application to the Law and Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;
2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the Law and Justice Planning Office;
3. That the Law and Justice Grant Coordinator is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the Law and Justice Planning Office;
