PROPOSED MOTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE
U. S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR FUNDING A
SPECIAL FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN

WHEREAS, Unemployment and Public Assistance levels are very high in King County.

WHEREAS, Proper nutrition for these large numbers of unemployed and welfare recipients is a recognized problem.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the King County Council as follows:

1. That the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute and file an application with the U. S. Department of Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Services requesting funds necessary to provide a Special Food Service Program for children.

2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to execute such contracts as are required by the U. S. Department of Agriculture.

3. That the Federal State Grant Coordinator is hereby authorized to provide additional information and to furnish such documentation as may be required by the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

4. That the United States of America, Department of Agriculture is hereby assured full compliance with such regulations effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
