

Motion authorizing County Executive to execute contract with James R. Laird Co., Inc. for completion of Revaluation of property in King County.

WHEREAS, the County has been engaged in the process of revaluation, and

WHEREAS, State law requires that that program be completed by July 1, 1973, and

WHEREAS, the use of contract services is necessary to achieve completion of the program, and

WHEREAS, a competitive bid procedure has been used to solicit contract services for appraisal, and

WHEREAS, the James R. Laird Co., Inc. has been the successful low bidder;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County that the King County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the James R. Laird Co., Inc. for a total compensation not to exceed \$1,245,000, to be funded from supplemental appropriation in 1970 and appropriations in 1973, and, further, that said contract payment shall require the James R. Laird Co., Inc. to accomplish the work stated in the contract attached to this motion, which simply stated shall cause the revaluation of 115,000 parcels of King County property.
