2 A MOTION encouraging the locating of the National
3 Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration at Sand
Point Naval Air Station.

4 WHEREAS, the King County Council urges the National Oceanic
5 and Atmospheric Administration to locate its facility in the
6 Puget Sound Region, and

7 WHEREAS, the Puget Sound Region is ideally suited for an
8 oceanographic research laboratory, and

9 WHEREAS, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration
10 is interested in the Sand Point area for the location of their
11 facility, and

12 WHEREAS, the construction of such facility should be com-
13 patible with the multi-use concept and land use of the general
14 Sand Point Community, and

15 WHEREAS, the multi-use concept of this land may include the
16 construction of parks and recreation facilities including
17 properly landscaped beach area for aquatic activities, and

18 WHEREAS, the multi-use concept of this land may include the
19 possible construction of a historical museum, and

20 WHEREAS, the multi-use concept of this land may include the
21 development of a proposed trail from Myrtle Edwards Park on Lake
22 Union to Sand Point, and

23 WHEREAS, the multi-use concept of this land may include pro-
24 viding adequate airport and aviation facilities for general
25 aviation, and

26 WHEREAS, the addition of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric
27 Administration installation in our area would provide much needed
28 jobs, and

29 WHEREAS, having the National Oceanic and Atmospheric
30 Administration located in our area would add to our research and
31 scientific prestige,
