

1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute  
2 and submit a grant application to the Office of Economic  
3 Opportunity in the amount of \$151,950 to supplement  
4 the county-wide drug rehabilitation program.

5 WHEREAS, the Office of Economic Opportunity has funds  
6 available for programs designed to treat drug dependent persons  
7 and to thereby reduce the problems related to drug abuse; and

8 WHEREAS, the County and the City of Seattle jointly  
9 sponsored and received approval of a grant from the National  
10 Institute of Mental Health for a county-wide drug rehabilitation  
11 program administered through the Center for Addiction Services;  
12 and

13 WHEREAS, this grant would supplement said program:

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

15 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized  
16 to make application to the Office of Economic Opportunity on  
17 behalf of King County.

18 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and  
19 directed to file and execute such application and contracts as  
20 are required by the Office of Economic Opportunity.

21 3. The King County Mental Health/Mental Retardation  
22 Director is hereby named the authorized correspondent for King  
23 County and is further authorized to furnish such additional  
24 information and documents as may be required by the granting  
25 agency as specified in Section 1.

26 4. The United States of America, Department of Justice,  
27 is hereby assured full compliance with such regulations effec-  
28 tuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
