

1 A MOTION authorizing application for NO. funding assistance for two bank protection
2 projects on Green River, JOB NOS. GR-2-72
3 and GR-3-72, in King County, Washington,
4 to the United States Army Corps of Engi-
5 neers as provided by the Flood Control Act
6 of 1946.

7 WHEREAS, The United States has made available funds for
8 two projects for bank protection on Green River in King County,
9 Washington, substantially as shown on drawing No. E-12-7-190
10 (Exhibit A) dated 7 June 1972, attached hereto and made a part
11 hereof; and

12 WHEREAS, The United States Army Corps of Engineers estimates
13 JOB NO. GR-2-72 at approximately \$27,000 and JOB NO. GR-3-73
14 at approximately \$10,000, neither exceeding the Corps authorized
15 limit of \$50,000 per project; and

16 WHEREAS, In accordance with the provisions of Section 14
17 of the Flood Control Act, approved 24 July 1946, and pertinent
18 administrative determinations, such funds cannot be used until
19 a responsible local agency has given assurances satisfactory to
20 the Secretary of the Army that it will:

21 a. Furnish without cost to the United States all lands,
22 easements, disposal areas, rights-of-way, and rights-of-entry,
23 and perform all necessary alterations to utilities; and

24 b. Hold the United States free from any claims for damages
25 due to the construction and subsequent maintenance of the project;
26 and

27 c. Maintain and operate project works after construction,
28 in accordance with regulations prescribed by the Secretary of
29 the Army; and

30 d. Prevent any encroachment on the completed work; and

31 e. Pay all costs in excess of \$50,000; and

32 f. Make a cash contribution of \$0 which is the presently
33 estimated cost over \$50,000. However, if it becomes apparent,
prior to the time construction is complete, that more than
\$50,000 will be expended upon this project, the remaining
project cost above \$50,000 will be paid by King County prior

1 to any expenditures over \$50,000. The total cash contribution
 2 by King County will be determined upon project completion, and
 3 any balance owing to King County or the Government will be ad-
 4 justed at that time; and

5 g. Seed the project areas to provide grass cover; and

6 h. Remove and replace fences.

7 WHEREAS, King County is empowered by the laws of the
 8 State of Washington to furnish the local cooperation above set
 9 forth, and to levy taxes in the amounts necessary to fulfill
 10 the terms of cooperation;

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

12 1. That the County does hereby assume and agree to perform
 13 the above-named obligations;

14 2. That there is hereby granted to the United States of
 15 America, its agents and its contractors, the right to enter
 16 on and use any lands owned by or under the control of said County
 17 for the purposes of constructing the project;

18 3. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator for King
 19 County is hereby designated as the authorized correspondent
 20 to provide additional information and to furnish such documents
 21 as may be required by said agency;
