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pertinent administrative determinations, such funds cannot be used until a responsible local agency has given assurances satisfactory to the Secretary of the Army that it will:

- a. Furnish without cost to the United States all lands, easements, disposal areas, rights-of-way and rights-of-entry necessary for construction of the project, including gravel sources, and perform all necessary alterations to utilities; and
- b. Hold the United States free from damages due to the construction and subsequent maintenance of the project; and
- c. Maintain and operate the project works after construction, in accordance with regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Army; and
  - d. Prevent any encroachment on the completed work; and
  - e. Remove and replace fences; and

f. Seed the project areas after completion.

WHEREAS, The King County Council is empowered by the laws of the State of Washington to furnish the local cooperation above set forth, and to levy taxes in the amounts necessary to fulfill the terms of cooperation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1	1. That the County does hereby assume and agree to perform
2	the above-named obligations;
3	2. That there is hereby granted to the United States of
· 4	America, its agents and its contractors, the right to enter on
5	and use any lands owned by or under the control of said County
6	for the purposes of constructing the project;
7	3. That the Federal/State Grant Coordinator for King
8	County is hereby designated as the authorized correspondent
9	to provide additional information and to furnish such documents
10	as may be required by said agency;
