1 A MOTION stating the intent of King County to
2 apply for and maintain its eligibility for
3 flood and mudslide insurance under Sections
4 1910.3 and 1910.4 of the National Flood Insurance
5 Regulations.

6 WHEREAS, certain portions of unincorporated King County are sub-
7 ject to periodic flooding and/or mudslides from the rivers, streams,
8 and Puget Sound causing serious damage to residential properties within
9 these areas; and

10 WHEREAS, relief is available in the form of flood insurance as
11 authorized by the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 as amended; and

12 WHEREAS, it is the intent of this Council to comply with land use
13 and management criteria regulations as required in said Act; and

14 WHEREAS, it is also the intent of this Council to recognize and
15 duly evaluate flood and/or mudslide hazards in all official actions
16 relating to land use in the flood plains and/or mudslide areas having
17 special flood and/or mudslide hazards; and

18 WHEREAS, the Code Citations of this State's enabling legislation
19 and of any resulting county ordinance that authorizes this County to
20 adopt land use and control measures are R.C.W. 36.70, Washington State
21 planning enabling legislation; R.C.W. 58.15, Washington State sub-
22 division enabling legislation; R.C.W. 86.16, Washington State flood
23 control zoning; Chapter 286, Laws 1971, 1st Ex. Session, Washington
24 State Shoreline Management Act; King County Home Rule Charter; and
25 Ordinance No. 00263, King County planning implementation ordinance.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

27 The King County Council assures the Federal Insurance Administra-
28 tion that it will take such legislative and executive action as re-
29 quired to meet the following:

30 1. Submit a copy of the land use and control measures the com-
31 munity has adopted in order to meet the requirements of Sections 1910.3
32 and 1910.4 of the National Flood Insurance Regulations.

33 2. Take such other official action as may be reasonably neces-
34 sary to carry out the objectives of the program. Such actions will

1 include but not be limited to:

2 (a) Delineating or assisting the Administrator, at his
3 request, in delineating the limits of the areas having special flood
4 and/or mudslide hazards on available local maps of sufficient scale
5 to identify the location of building sites.

6 (b) Providing such information as the Administrator may
7 request concerning present uses and occupancy of the flood plains
8 and/or mudslide areas.

9 (c) Maintaining for public inspection and furnishing upon
10 request, with respect to each area having special flood hazards, in-
11 formation on elevations (in relation to mean sea level) of the lowest
12 floors of all new or substantially improved structures and, where
13 there is a basement, the distance between the first floor and the
14 bottom of the lowest opening where water flowing on the ground will
15 enter; and

16 (d) The County Executive shall provide the name of the
17 individual and department that will be responsible for furnishing the
18 first floor elevation information.

19 (e) Cooperate with Federal, State, and local agencies and
20 private firms which undertake to study, survey, map, and identify
21 flood plain or mudslide areas, and cooperate with neighboring com-
22 munities with respect to management of adjoining flood plain and/or
23 mudslide areas in order to prevent aggravation of existing hazards.

24 BE IT FURTHER MOVED, that this Council hereby appoints the
25 Department of Planning with the responsibility, authority and means
26 to submit on the anniversary date of the community's initial
27 eligibility, an annual report to the Administrator on the progress
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made during the past year within the community in the development and implementation of flood plain and/or mudslide area management measures and to implement all other commitments made herein.
