A MOTION supporting the passage of State Referendum 29.

WHEREAS, State Referendum 29, authorizes the issuance and sale of state general obligation bonds in the sum of \$25 million to provide funds for planning, acquisition, construction and improvement of Health and Social Services facilities, and

WHEREAS, the bonds will be retired from unpledged state retail sales tax revenues or other means authorized by the legislature, and,

WHEREAS, the passage of State Referendum 29 will result in (1) additional residential facilities for the mentally retarded, (2) regional vocational rehabilitation facilities and sheltered workshops for disabled persons, (3) community-based correction facilities for both juveniles and adults, (4) facilities for drug users and alcoholics and (5) multi-service centers for the elderly, youth, those eligible for public assistance and others, and

WHEREAS, King County will benefit from these new facilities and from the creation of the new jobs generated by this construction,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council hereby supports the passage of State Referendum 29 and encourages the voters of King County to vote in favor of State  $R_{\rm e}$  ferendum in the November 1972 General Election.
