

1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
2 execute and submit a grant application to the
3 State Law & Justice Planning Office for funds
4 in the amount of \$74,390 to enable the Office
of Public Defense to continue their defense
services to indigents.

5 WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of
6 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law
7 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice,
8 through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office, and;

9 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the constitutional
10 requirement to appoint counsel for indigent misdemeanants facing
11 loss of liberty, and;

12 WHEREAS, this grant would permit the continuation of these
13 defense services;

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

15 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to
16 make application for funds in the amount of \$74,390 to the State
17 Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

18 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and
19 directed to file and execute such application and contracts as
20 are required by the State;

21 3. That the King County Law & Justice Planning Office is
22 named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further
23 authorized to furnish such additional information and documents
24 as may be required by the State;

25 4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter
26 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary with the
27 Defender Association for the implementation of the project.

1 5. That the United States of America, Department of
2 Justice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full
3 compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
