A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the State Law & Justice Planning Office for funds in the amount of \$74,390 to enable the Office of Public Defense to continue their defense services to indigents.

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice, through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office, and;

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the constitutional requirement to appoint counsel for indigent misdemeanants facing loss of liberty, and;

WHEREAS, this grant would permit the continuation of these defense services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$74,390 to the State Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;
- 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the State;
- 3. That the King County Law & Justice Planning Office is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further | authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State;
- 4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary with the Defender Association for the implementation of the project.
