

1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
2 execute and submit a grant application to the
3 State Law & Justice Planning Office for funds
4 in the amount of \$103,437 to enable the Univ-
5 ersity of Washington Minority Affairs Office
6 to develop their Prisoner Education Project.

7 WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of
8 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law
9 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice,
10 through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office; and,

11 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to develop
12 rehabilitation and education programs within the criminal justice
13 system; and,

14 WHEREAS, this grant would help support habilitation reform
15 through the establishment of training programs for ex-offenders;

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

17 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to
18 make application for funds in the amount of \$103,437 to the State
19 Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

20 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and
21 directed to file and execute such application and contracts as
22 are required by the State;

23 3. That the King County Law & Justice Planning Office is
24 named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further
25 authorized to furnish such additional information and documents
26 as may be required by the State;

27 4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter
28 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary with the
29 University of Washington, Minority Affairs Office, for the imple-
30 mentation of the project.

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
5. That the United States of America, Department of Justice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
