MOTION NO. 1031

A MOTION concurring with the recommendation of the Deputy Zoning & Subdivision Examiner on the Preliminary Plat of Snoqualmie West, File No. 972-2.

WHEREAS, the King County Council has not adopted procedures for placing a moratorium on platting activity during an Area Zoning Program, and plats have heretofore been regulated by existing zoning and existing platting standards, and

WHEREAS, the applicant has submitted a plat which makes excellent use of strategic open space and provides for stream bank access and flood storage, and

WHEREAS, the applicant has a substantial involvement in the proposed plat, based on standards and zoning requirements which have been currently applied to other plats in Eastern King County,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The Council does hereby concur with the recommendation of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner to approve the Preliminary Plat of Snoqualmie West, subject to the conditions stated in Items 2-a through 3-1 in the Examiner's Report, File No. 972-2.
