PROPOSED MOTION NO. 10-16

A MOTION authorizing the creation of a County Wide Flood Control District Steering Committee.

WHEREAS, King County desires to investigate the advisability and need for establishing a county wide flood control zone district, and

WHEREAS, R.C.W. 86.15.040 specifically requires the approval of the legislative body of each city, town or district prior to the creation of such a zone district,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to establish a County Wide Flood Control District Steering Committee composed of representatives of the cities in King County and presently constituted flood control zone districts, and


That the purpose of the steering committee shall be to investigate and report to the Executive and the King County Council on the following:

1. The feasibility of establishing a county wide flood control district.
2. The means of financing capital improvements as well as operation and maintenance costs.
3. The opinions of the cities they represent, and


That the Steering Committee shall submit a final report of their recommendations within six months of the formation of the Steering Committee.
