A MOTION relating to the completion of the county house addressing program.

WHEREAS, King County has recently established an Emergency Medical Services Division, within the Seattle-King County Health Department, to aid in the planning and delivery of emergency medical services throughout the County, and

WHEREAS, King County has made progress on implementing the 911 Emergency Notification System throughout the County, and

WHEREAS, both programs rely on the prompt location of the emergency, and

WHEREAS, the County program of mapping, signing and addressing in the rural areas has not been completed,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby directed to assign priority to the county house addressing program and if necessary appropriate Revenue Sharing Funds necessary to quickly complete the task.
