

MOTION NO. 1088

1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive
2 to execute and submit a grant application
3 to the State Law and Justice Planning
4 Office for funds in the amount of \$104,500
5 to support a Subsidized Employment Program
6 for school drop-outs operated by the Depart-
7 ment of Community Development, Division of
8 Youth Affairs.

9 WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of
10 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law
11 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice,
12 through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office, and

13 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to assist
14 young, school drop-outs in finding meaningful employment, and

15 WHEREAS, this grant would help provide work experience
16 to school drop-outs under the age of eighteen and in turn assist
17 them in becoming more useful citizens, and

18 WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to provide
19 as support to this program approximately \$21,000 as an in-kind
20 match and \$14,000 as a cash match,

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to
23 make application for funds in the amount of \$104,500 to the State
24 Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

25 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and
26 directed to file and execute such application and contracts as
27 are required by the State;

28 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named
29 the authorized correspondent for King County and is, further
30 authorized to furnish such additional information and documents
31 as may be required by the State;
