

MOTION NO. 1110

1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive
2 to execute and submit a grant application
3 to the State Law & Justice Planning
4 Office for funds in the amount of \$200,000
5 to enable the Department of Community
6 Development/Division of Youth Affairs
7 to implement a Comprehensive Youth Service
8 System in King County, 3-L-318.

9 WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of
10 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law
11 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice,
12 through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office, and

13 WHEREAS, this program seeks to reduce delinquency by
14 providing community-based services for the youth of King County,
15 and

16 WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide
17 \$40,000 in-kind contribution and to provide \$26,667 in a cash
18 match for support of this project,

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized
21 to make application for funds in the amount of \$200,000 to the
22 State Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

23 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and
24 directed to file and execute such application and contracts as
25 are required by the State;


26 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named
27 the authorized correspondent for King County and is further
28 authorized to furnish such additional information and documents
29 as may be required by the State;

30 4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter
31 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
32 implementation of the project.

1 5. That the United States of America, Department of
2 Justice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full
3 compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.


