3 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive
4 to execute and submit a grant application
5 to the State Law & Justice Planning Office
6 for funds in the amount of \$102,674 to
7 continue support of The Ark, a crisis
8 intervention center for teen-age girls,
9 File No. 73-L-327.

10 WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act
11 of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by Law
12 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice,
13 through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office, and

14 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need for
15 an intensive intervention service for girls expressing delinquent
16 behavior or undergoing crisis situations that may require short-
17 term residential care and counseling to prevent them from
18 becoming wards of the court, and

19 WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide
20 \$20,600 in kind contribution and to provide \$13,820 in a cash
21 match for support of this project,

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

23 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized
24 to make application for funds in the amount of \$102,674 to the
25 State Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

26 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and
27 directed to file and execute such application and contracts as
28 are required by the State;


29 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named
30 the authorized correspondent for King County and is further
31 authorized to furnish such additional information and documents
32 as may be required by the State;

2 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
3 implementation of the project.


4 5. That the United States of America, Department of
