A MOTION authorizing the expenditure of \$10,000 from the Council Budget for legal research to discover and determine the extent of the County's legal authority to develop and implement new planning methods and zoning techniques.

WHEREAS, the citizens of King County would benefit from innovative progress in County Land Use Planning, and

WHEREAS, the Council has received a proposal from Derrill T. Bastian and Jerome L. Hillis to perform legal research toward this end, such proposal requested by Motion 1087,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


Derrill T. Bastian and Jerome L. Hillis are hereby engaged by the Council to do legal research which will explore and define legal authority enabling the County to modernize its planning and zoning.

The fee for the legal research is not to exceed \$10,000, to be paid from the 1973 operating budget of the Council.


The cooperation of the Prosecuting Attorney's Office and the Land Use Management Division are requested in coordinating and integrating into one system the requirements which the County must meet in dealing with State laws which now require a multiplicity of procedures and permits.
