Mental Health, for funds in the amount of
\$75,000 to develop a locally based informa-
tion/program evaluation system, 73-M-328.

5 WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health, Education and
6 Welfare through the National Institute of Mental Health, provides
7 for the award of grants in the areas of program planning,
8 research and evaluation, and

9 WHEREAS, the development of a consolidated reporting system
10 would enhance program effectiveness in the delivery of health and
11 social services in the areas of alcoholism, drug abuse, develop-
12 mental disability and mental health,

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

14 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized
15 to make application for funds in the amount of \$75,000 to the
16 U.S. Department of Helath, Education and Welfare, National Insti-
17 tute of Mental Health on behalf of King County to develop a locally
18 based information/program evaluation system;

19 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and
20 directed to file and execute such application and contracts as
21 are required by the U.S. Department of Health, Education and
22 Welfare;


23 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named
24 the authorized correspondent for King County and is further
25 authorized to furnish such additional information and documents
26 as may be required by the U.S. Department of Health, Education
27 and Welfare;


1 4. That the U.S. Department of Health, Education and
