MOTION NO. 1146

A MOTION extending the time period within which the Open Space Taxation Agreement between King County and Twin Lakes Golf and Country Club, Land Use Management File No. 407-72-S, must be signed and returned to the King County Council.

WHEREAS, an open space taxation agreement between King County and Twin Lakes Golf and Country Club, Land Use Management File No. 407-72-S was signed by the Chairman of the King County Council and mailed to Twin Lakes Golf and Country Club on April 9, 1973; and

WHEREAS, the Open Space Taxation Act Rules, W.A.C. 458-30, require that the open space taxation agreement be signed by the owners and returned to the Council within twenty-five days after the mailing of the agreement by the Council, unless an extension is granted by the Council; and

WHEREAS, Twin Lakes Golf and Country Club has requested an extension of said time period until the King County Department of Assessment has adopted a method by which the current use value of golf courses will be determined;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The time period within which the open space taxation agreement between King County and Twin Lakes Golf and Country Club, must be signed and returned to the King County Council is extended from May 4, 1973 to May 29, 1973.
