A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a grant application to the State Law & Justice Planning Office for funds in the amount of \$48,963 to continue the work of the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council, 73-L-331

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice, through the Washington State Law & Justice Planning Office, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council is a necessary forum to discuss problems of the criminal justice system with key law enforcement, government and citizens representatives, and

WHEREAS, the proposed work of the Council outlined in proposed grant 73-L-331 will significantly increase the usefulness of said Council to those involved in developing an efficient criminal justice system, and

WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to provide \$8,161 in a cash match for support of this project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$48,963 to the State Law & Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;
- 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the State;
- 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State;
