

MOTION NO. 1191

A MOTION recognizing the formation of a Lake Washington Regional Citizens Advisory Committee and a Lake Washington Regional Technical Committee and to delegate the responsibility for the City of Kirkland to administer grant monies from the State Department of Ecology to be used for the purpose of developing regional shoreline policies for Lake Washington.

WHEREAS, by adoption of emergency State regulation, Lake Washington will be designated as a region for the purpose of developing regional shoreline policies, and

WHEREAS, the regional designation will result in the development of consistent, overall policies for the Lake as a unit, and

WHEREAS, to implement the citizens involvement program as described in the Final Guidelines of the Shoreline Management Act of 1971, a committee framework has been established, and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Ecology has made available a grant of \$10,000 to the regional body for development of regional policies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

(1) The County Council hereby recognizes the formation of a Lake Washington Regional Citizens Advisory Committee and Lake Washington Regional Technical Committee, pursuant to Section 11 of the Shoreline Management Act of 1971, to develop regional policies for Lake Washington.

(2) The County Council hereby authorizes the Executive to contract with the State Department of Ecology and with the City
