

MOTION NO. 1297

1 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
2 execute and submit a grant application to the
3 Robert Wood Johnson Foundation for funds in
4 the amount of \$400,000 to establish an Integrated
5 Emergency Medical Services System for Seattle-
6 King County, M-344

7 WHEREAS, the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, a private
8 national philanthropic organization, has established a
9 competitive program aimed at providing basic support for the
10 establishment of regional emergency medical communications
11 systems, and

12 WHEREAS, the Seattle-King County Department of Public
13 Health has a Division of Emergency Medical Services which is
14 seeking assistance in implementing its comprehensive emergency
15 medical communication system, and

16 WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of
17 King County to have available immediate emergency medical
18 service,

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized
21 to make application for funds in the amount of \$400,000 to
22 the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, a private, national
23 philanthropic organization on behalf of King County.

24 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and
25 directed to file and execute such application and contracts
26 as are required by the Robert Wood Foundation.


27 3. That the Federal/State Relations Division is named
28 the authorized correspondent for King County and is further
29 authorized to furnish such additional information and documents
30 as may be required by the Foundation.


4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for implementation of the project.
