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MOTION NO. 1210

A MOTION indicating the Council's approval of reclassification of certain property belonging to Loren E. Kellie, designated Land Use Management File No. 116-73-P.

WHEREAS the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on the application of Loren E. Kellie for a reclassification of property, Land Use Management File No. 116-73-P has been appealed; and

WHEREAS the Council has reviewed the record and the written appeal arguments on this matter; and

WHEREAS the applicant and the owners of the adjacent property to the west have demonstrated that a plan for the coordinated development of the two properties can be prepared and agreed upon between the owners; and

WHEREAS the Council finds the Zoning and Subdivision

Examiner made an error in judgement when he concluded that the reclassification of the property to CG, subject to conditions, would be detrimental to adjacent properties;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The application of Loren E. Kellie for a reclassification of property, File No. 116-73-P, shall be approved with the following modifications and subject to the satisfaction of the following conditions:

- 1. The east half of the subject property shall be classified SR (Potential BC) in lieu of SR (Potential CG).
- 2. The west half of the subject property shall be classified CG subject to the following conditions:
 - a. The applicant shall obtain final approval of a planned unit development, for a motor home sales and service facility, within twentyfour months from the date of Council action on this motion;
 - b. The planned unit development shall conform to the minimum standards and requirements set forth in Council Motion No. 693;

1 2	c. The preliminary planned unit development plans shall show the proposed common development features of both the subject property and the adjacent property to
3	the west;
. 4	d. The classification of the subject property
5	shall revert to SR (Potential BC) if the use of the site for the sale and servicing
6	of motor homes is terminated, or if the ownership of the property changes.
