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MOTION NO. 1227

A MOTION concurring with the recommendation of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner regarding the Preliminary Plat of Whispering Heights Division #4, designated File No. 673-7, and adding conditions thereto.

WHEREAS the Council has reviewed the written recommendation of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner attached hereto which was filed with the Administrator-Clerk of the Council on July 25, 1973, regarding the Preliminary Plat of Whispering Heights Division #4, designated by the Land Use Management File No. 673-7; and

WHEREAS the Council finds that drainage problems are crucial in this plat and a more definite statement of Council intent is needed;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council concurs with the recommendation of the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner, dated July 17, 1973, with the following additional conditions:


- (1) Drainage plans shall include a timetable for facility construction requirements;
- (2) Drainage plans shall insure on site retention of any peak flow increases caused by the proposed development.
