

MOTION NO. 1285

1 A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive
2 to enter into the appropriate contracts for
3 animal sheltering and animal neutering/spaying.

4 WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that the existing
5 animal shelter is inadequate; and

6 WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that a coordin-
7 ated program with the City of Seattle is the least expensive
8 method of providing animal shelter services for the residents of
9 Seattle and King County, and

10 WHEREAS, the Council of King County intends that the animals
11 in North King County be sheltered in that area; and that the
12 animals in East King County be sheltered in that area; and

13 WHEREAS, the Council of King County intends that an animal
14 shelter be built in South King County where 65% of the county's
15 animal control enforcement takes place; and

16 WHEREAS, the Council of King County intends that a low-cost
17 neuter/spay program be established.

18 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

19 The King County Executive is authorized to proceed with
20 plans to construct a shelter in South King County. The County
21 intends to provide shelter for North County animals at the City
22 of Seattle facility and to enter into contracts to shelter East
23 County animals.
