A MOTION Authorizing the County Executive to execute and submit a joint application to the State Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation requesting funds in the amount of \$181,364 to develop boat moorage at Luther Burbank County Park.

WHEREAS, King County owns certain lands known as Luther Burbank Park, and

WHEREAS, The Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission and King County wish to participate in a joint application to the State Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for the development of transient boat moorage at Luther Burbank Park for public recreational purposes, and

WHERFAS, the entire \$181,364 will come from the Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission share of the Outdoor Recreation Account as administered by the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Marine Recreation Land Act, State and Federal funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the development of outdoor recreational facilities of local public bodies, and

WHEREAS, the County Council, King County, Washington considers it in the best public interest to develop transient boat moorage at the park listed below:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

- 1. That the County Executive is hereby authorized to make joint application with the Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission to the State Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for funding in the amount of \$181,364 for transient moorage facilities at Luther Burbank Park and execute such contracts as are required by the State.
- 2. That the Federal State Relations Division is hereby designated as the authorized correspondent to provide additional information and to furnish such documents as may be required by the State.
