2 A MOTION Authorizing Application to the United
3 States Department of Commerce, Economic Development
4 Administration for a Grant in the Amount of Approx-
5 imately \$765,000 to Support a Stadium Exhibition Facil-
6 ities Project, County File No. CED-349.

7 WHEREAS, Public Works and Development Facilities grant monies
8 as authorized by P.L. 89-136, as amended, have been made available to the
9 United States Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration,
10 for grants to public bodies to aid in financing the construction of spec-
11 ific public projects, and

12 WHEREAS, The proposed Stadium Exhibition Facilities Project
13 will enable the King County Domed Stadium to achieve improved flexibility
14 for accommodating trade show and exhibition events, and will renovate an
15 existing on-site building for Stadium support activities, and

16 WHEREAS, King County recognizes an in-kind match of approx-
17 imately \$512,000,

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

19 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to execute
20 and submit a grant application to the United States Department of Commerce,
21 Economic Development Administration, for funds in the amount of approximately
22 \$765,000 for the Stadium Exhibition Facilities Project, CED-349.

23 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to
24 file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the
25 Economic Development Administration.

26 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the author-
27 ized correspondent for King County, and is further authorized to furnish
28 such additional information and documents as may be required by the Economic
29 Development Administration.

1 4. The United States Department of Commerce, Economic Develop-
2 ment Administration, is hereby assured full compliance with such regulations
3 effectuating Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.

4 5. Assurance is made to the Economic Development Administration
5 that every effort will be made to successfully complete the project at a cost
6 not greater than approved for funding. However, if such changes do occur,
7 prior approval will be received from the Economic Development Administration.

8 6. King County guarantees the successful and timely completion
9 of said project to the satisfaction of the Economic Development Administration.
