A MOTION authorizing an exchange of lands at

Lake Wilderness Park Site.

WHEREAS, King County owns certain lands situated in King County, State of Washington, known as a portion of the Lake Wilderness Park Site, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council deems it necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County to exchange these lands for those owned by Raymond H. Coleman and Gwendolyn Coleman, husband and wife, and

WHEREAS, the Coleman's have determined that it is essential to acquire the title to the land owned by King County and described herein as Parcel A in order to complete the development of the Lake Wilderness Golf Course which they own and operate, and

WHEREAS, investigation reveals that the lands owned by the Coleman's are more suitable for use by the County and the lands owned by the County are more suitable as a portion of the public golf course being expanded by the Coleman's, and

WHEREAS, investigation further reveals that the two parcels of land described herein are of similar size and comparable value, and that the value of the County real property to be exchanged is not more than the value of the real property to be acquired by such exchange, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council does hereby determine that the lands described herein as Parcel A are not necessary to the future forseeable needs of King County, and that the real property to be acquired by this exchange is necessary for the future forseeable needs of King County, and deems it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of King County to exchange these County lands described herein as Parcel A for those described herein as Parcel B,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to direct the Prosecuting Attorney to commence any legal action necessary to authorize the exchange, and to execute the necessary instruments to convey to Raymond H. Coleman and Gwendolyn Coleman, husband and wife, Parcel A described as follows:
