2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
3 execute and submit a grant application to the
4 U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare
5 for funds in the amount of approximately \$50,000
6 for a King County Mental Retardation Services
7 Planning Support Project, PH-357.

8 WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health, Education and
9 Welfare, through the Social and Rehabilitation Service, is
10 authorized to make planning grants to local governments to de-
11 velop comprehensive plans for mental retardation, and

12 WHEREAS, the King County Mental Retardation Board supports
13 and recommends the development of a five-year comprehensive plan
14 for mental retardation services in King County, and

15 WHEREAS, the proposed planning grant will develop a long
16 range plan for mental retardation services and facilities within
17 King County, and

18 WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to provide
19 as support to this program approximately \$12,500 in contributed
20 goods and services,

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make
23 application for funds in the amount of approximately \$50,000 to
24 the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare on behalf
25 of King County for Mental Retardation Services Planning Support
26 Project, PH-357.

27 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized and
28 directed to file and execute such application and contracts as
29 are required by the U.S. Department of Health, Education and
30 Welfare;

31 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the
32 authorized correspondent for King County and is further author-
33 ized to furnish such additional information and documents as may
be required by the U.S. Department of Health, Education and
Welfare;



4. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;


5. The U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
