2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to  
3 execute and submit a grant application to the  
4 State Law and Justice Planning Office for funds  
5 in the amount of \$110,155 to provide funds for  
6 employment of administrative start-up staff and  
7 pre-trial release interviewer staff for the pro-  
8 posed King County Department of Rehabilitative  
9 Services, BPP-360

10 WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act  
11 of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law  
12 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U. S. Department of  
13 Justice, through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning  
14 Office, and

15 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need for a  
16 King County Department of Rehabilitative Services, and

17 WHEREAS, the proposed grant will provide needed start-up  
18 monies associated with establishing a Department of Rehabilitative  
19 Services and also provide necessary funds to employ interviewers  
20 to perform the duties required by the new rules for the Superior  
21 Court regarding pre-trial release, and

22 WHEREAS, the County recognizes its obligation to provide  
23 as support to this program approximately \$12,239 as a cash match,

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

25 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to  
26 make application for funds in the amount of \$110,155 to the State  
27 Law and Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County for  
28 staffing of the proposed King County Department of Rehabilitative  
29 Services.

30 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed  
31 to file and execute such application and contracts as are re-  
32 quired by the State.



3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the authorized correspondent for King County and is further authorized to furnish such additional information and documents as may be required by the State.


4. The United States of America, Department of Justice, and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
