2 A MOTION Authorizing the County Executive to
3 execute and submit a grant application to the
4 State Law and Justice Planning Office for funds
5 in the amount of \$51,000 to enable the Prosecut-
6 ing Attorney's Office to continue the Fraud
7 Division, PA-362.

8 WHEREAS, The Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act
9 of 1968, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Law
10 Enforcement Assistance Administration, U. S. Department of
11 Justice, through the Washington State Law and Justice Planning
12 Office, and

13 WHEREAS, The County Council recognizes the need to detect
14 and prosecute those engaged in commercial fraud, and

15 WHEREAS, This grant would permit the continuation of this
16 unit of skilled lawyers and investigators to specialize in the
17 detection and prosecution of these crimes, and

18 WHEREAS, The County Council has approved this program as
19 an element of the 1974 King County Law and Justice Plan, and

20 WHEREAS, The County recognizes its obligation to provide
21 as support to this program approximately \$88,000 as a cash match,

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

23 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to
24 make application for funds in the amount of \$51,000 to the State
25 Law and Justice Planning Office on behalf of King County;

26 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized and dir-
27 ected to file and execute such application and contracts as are
28 required by the State;

29 3. The Federal/State Relations Division is named the
30 authorized correspondent for King County and is further author-
31 ized to furnish such additional information and documents as may
32 be required by the State;

1 4. The County Executive is also authorized to enter
2 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the im-
3 plementation of the project.

4 5. The United States of America, Department of Justice,
5 and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance
6 with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
