

MOTION NO. 1508

1 A MOTION Authorizing the County Executive to
2 Apply for a Loan of \$119,556 from the Wash-
3 ington State Department of Ecology for the
4 Cedar Hills Landfill Leachate Collection and
5 Disposal System, No. PW-356

6 WHEREAS, The State Department of Ecology is authorized to
7 administer and distribute funds for the planning, acquisition,
8 construction and improvement of public waste disposal facilities,
9 and,

10 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Div-
11 ision, has the responsibility for the environmentally safe dis-
12 posal of solid waste at King County disposal facilities, and,

13 WHEREAS, The Cedar Hills Landfill Facility has been cited
14 for violation of Chapter 90.48.080 RCW for pollution of Mason and
15 Issaquah Creeks, and,

16 WHEREAS, King County has a statutory responsibility for
17 taking immediate and positive action toward eliminating the
18 source of said pollution, and,

19 WHEREAS, The proposed loan from the Department of Ecology
20 will provide for leachate collection and control system for the
21 disposal park and sewage system for the Alcoholism Treatment
22 Center, and,

23 WHEREAS, King County recognizes its obligation to repay
24 this interest-free loan to the Department of Ecology, State of
25 Washington, over a period of not more than five years,

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED By the Council of King County:

27 1. That the King County Executive is hereby authorized
28 to make application for loan monies in the amount of \$119,556 to
29 the State Department of Ecology on behalf of King County;


1 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized and

7 may be required by the State;


8 4. That the County Executive is also authorized to enter
